



The aim is to generate an **open and inter-disciplinary knowledge**, in order to **promote social innovation**, **positive social and cultural change**. This is a way to respond to the challenges and leading international issues.



RESPONDING TO THE HUMANITARIAN CRISIS

Example: CULTURAL CORRIDORS FOR REFUGEES: Launching training programmes, with the aim of providing the refugees with technical and professional skills useful to their insertion in the world of work, stressing on profiles related to assisting non self-sufficient people and families

Beyond the traditional Third Mission

- A framework to create a bridge between University and society, where research results and educational skills will be transferred to an added value set of activities for driving the University to the new challenges of the future society needs.
- "Third Mission" at the University of Rome Tor Vergata means to create collaboration for developing ideas and talents to be discovered by industries, dealing with institutions and society, in order to make a better future for everyone.



BIOSC

Bioscience Genomics is a spin off between the University of Rome Tor Vergata and Bioscience Institute in San Marino, in the field of bio-medicine and healthcare (a fiveyear framework agreement focused on noninvasive prenatal testing with **BGI** dx) **Captiks**, SPIN OFF Tor Vergata - research group Hiteg (*Health Involved Technical Engineering Group*) at the Department of Electronic Engineering. Captiks mission is to change the way people interact with machines.
