

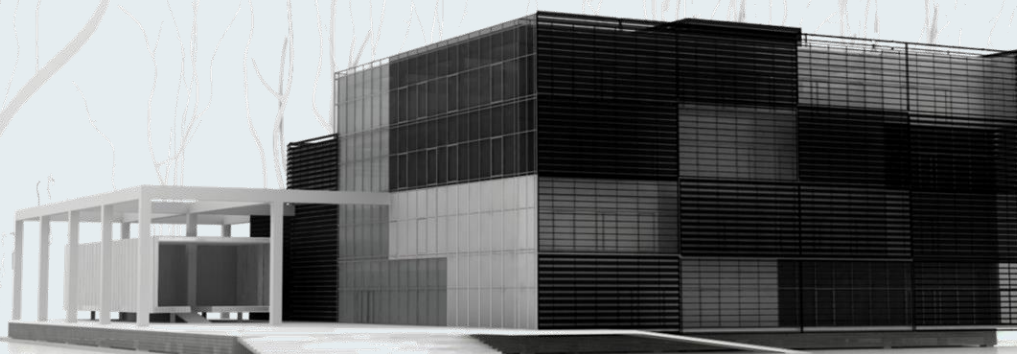

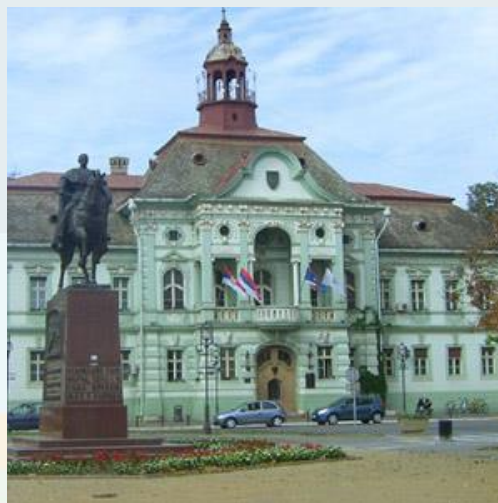

## INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMMES FOR THE MOBILITY OF STAFF AND STUDENTS

### Erasmus+ KA1

**Inter-institutional agreements with Programme country HEIs and UNS in constant growth since 2015 (more than 220 IIAs signed)**

### **Results of calls for outgoing mobility at UNS per academic year:**

Calls during academic 2015/2016: 387 selected students and staff (224 students / 163 staff)

Calls during academic 2016/2017: 545 selected students and staff (249 students / 296 staff)

Calls during academic 2017/2018: 739 selected students and staff (347 students / 392 staff)

Calls during academic 2018/2019: 623 selected students and staff (278 students / 345 staff)

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# INTERNATIONALISATION AT UNS

## UNIVERSITY OF NOVI SAD, INTERNATIONALISATION STRATEGY, adopted on July, 2016

### Main strategic objectives in the domain of international cooperation in HE and research:

- more extensive exchange of professors, researchers, students and administrative staff, within the Erasmus+ Programme, and other mobility schemes funded by the European Union;
- delivering innovative study programmes in collaboration with foreign higher education institutions;
- establishing broader cooperation with leading higher education institutions across the world;
- establishing broader cooperation with leading scientific institutions across the world;
- establishing extensive collaboration with scientists from other countries who are achieving outstanding results in their fields of expertise;
- creating conditions to involve a growing number of researchers from the University of Novi Sad in international scientific and development projects;
- creating conditions to ensure that leading scientists of the University of Novi Sad have ample opportunity to present their accomplishments to the international public.



# INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION AT UNS

## UNS AWARDED THE ERASMUS CHARTER FOR HIGHER EDUCATION

- The European Commission has adopted a decision on awarding the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education (ECHE) to the University of Novi Sad, after a successful evaluation of the application by the University of Novi Sad, submitted on March 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018.
- The Erasmus Charter describes the basic principles that each higher education institution should respect when applying for project funding, or when carrying out the project activities, in the framework of the whole Erasmus+ programme of the European Commission.

## Sustainability possible through regular University activity:

### KA1 – ERASMUS+ bilateral agreements concerning mobility

- deadlines for project application toward national agencies: Jan/Febr 2020 (application possible only by holder of ECHE – University (IRO))
- outgoing mobilities - strategic approach concerning the initiation of bilateral agreements (bottom-up approach) by faculties
- incoming mobilities - initiation of bilateral agreements (bottom-up approach) by faculties according to University procedures

**NOTE:** no restrictions concerning the no. of incoming mobilities/internships. Still, they have to be limited to few subject areas.

**A MUST:** study programmes/modules delivered in English! (ECHE Charter)

UNS will start with the implementation of a newly selected KA 103 projects in the next semester –the issue of scholarships' taxation should be solved by then at national level.

## **Sustainability possible through a NEW university project:**

### **KA1 – ERASMUS+ joint study programmes (ERASMUS MUNDUS)**

- highly prioritised by EC!
- a prestigious, integrated, international study programme, jointly delivered by an international consortium of higher education institutions (HEIs)
- all participating HEIs established in a Programme Country must be institutions that award the corresponding EMJMD Master degree, either joint or multiple/double. The degrees must be accredited, where applicable, by the competent national authorities in the countries where the HEIs are established
- a study period in at least two of the HEIs of the consortium located in Programme Countries
- a participating organisation can be any public or private organisation established in a Programme Country or in a Partner Country (minimum 3 HEIs from 3 different PCs)
- Duration: min 4 - max 6 years
- Application deadline: February 2020 or February 2021
